LCAP Goal: Conditions of Learning

Educator Professional Development

Professional learning includes training and coaching on Kagan, learning styles, academic standards, diversity and cultural understanding.

i-Ready Diagnostic Assessment

Diagnostic assessment administered in ELA and Math to identify and address the needs of all students.

1:1 Chromebook Devices

Chromebooks used to enhance GR K-8 technology-based instruction, collaboration, research, presentations and build keyboarding fluency.

LCAP Goal: Pupil Outcomes

Kagan Cooperative Learning

Kagan structures support student engagement and collaboration during instruction to increase equity in our classrooms.

Universal Access

Designated instruction provided to all students during the school day, based on need or skill.

Academic Advisors

Intermediate staff that coaches, supports, and monitors at-risk students to address social, behavioral, and academic needs. Works with parents on home-to-school communication.
